

2007 12 & Under Wisconsin Short Course State Championships

DATE: February 23 – 25, 2007

LOCATION: Waukesha South High School
401 E. Roberta Avenue
Waukesha, WI 53186

FACILITY: The Waukesha South Natatorium has 8 nine foot wide lanes that will be double laned lined for competition. One 25 yard warm-up/warm-down lane will be available throughout the meet for swimmers. Timing system consists of Colorado System 6 timing system, Colorado aqua grip touch pads and 9' x 13' full color video display board. The pool will be set up in the 25 yard pool configuration with a starting depth of 13.5 feet and turn depth at bulkhead of 5 feet 10 inches. The starting blocks are regulation height of 30". The natatorium seats 2,000 for athletes and spectators at deck level.

CLASSIFICATION: State Championship Time Standards, Wisconsin LSC-dictated

TENTATIVE SCHEDULE: The below timeline is an approximation. The exact timeline will be posted on www.wisconsinswimming.org after all entries have been received. All breaks will be determined after the timeline has been generated, and are at the meet management's discretion.

WARM-UPS: General warm-ups/circle swimming in all lanes for each warm-up session. Push-pace and sprint lanes will be opened & closed as necessary.

ENTRIES: Swimmers may compete in **FOUR** individual events per day plus relays up to a maximum of **SEVEN** individual events for the meet. This meet and the 13& Over meet are under separate sanctions. Qualified swimmers may compete in both meets up to each meet's maximum allowable entry.

ENTRY DEADLINE: **Entries should be e-mailed to Laurie Carlson (laurie@waukeshaexpress.org) by noon on Monday, February 19, 2007. This entry must include all additional qualifiers from the previous weekend's regional meets. No changes will be allowed to your entry after the entry deadline. A psych sheet will be posted by 5 PM on Tuesday, February 20th. If there is any meet management error with your entry you must contact Laurie by Wednesday, February 21st at 9:00 AM to get that error corrected. No changes will be allowed, only corrections due to meet management error. No additional entries will be accepted, so please review your entries carefully before e-mailing on February 19th.**

Your completed entry form, signed waiver and entry fees must be received by Tuesday, February 20, 2007. You will need to overnight your paperwork and payment so that they are received by February 20th. Please waive signature requirement on your package.

The meet will be run on Hy-tek's Meet Manager. All teams are encouraged to submit entries on disk in the Hy-Tek commlink format. Additional relay only swimmers will be accepted as a deck entry. Relay only swimmers must be deck entered by the end of the AM warm-up session for each day.

Relay entries: Teams may enter an "A" relay regardless of athlete count. In order for a team to enter a "B" relay, the team must have at least 5 individual qualifiers in that age group/gender. For example: your team has 5 10 & under boys qualified for the meet, your

team is allowed and A and B relay for all 10 & under boy relays. If you have 9 athletes, in that age group/gender then you can add a "C" relay, and so on.

Bonus event: A bonus event is allowed for swimmers that do not have the maximum number of events allowed for the meet. Swimmers should enter their bonus event at their best time or NT (if no seed time in that event).

Swimmers are only allowed ONE bonus event! *Please note: bonus events should be included in your hy-tek file and tagged as a bonus event. Also include a complete list of your bonus events for your team in your entry e-mail on February 19.**

- ENTRY FEES: \$3.00 LSC splash fee per swimmer
\$5.00 for 10 & under individual events
\$5.00 for 11 – 12 individual events
\$16.00 per relay
Please note: Relay-only swimmers MUST also pay the \$3.00 LSC splash fee and entered in event 201 for girls, 202 for boys.
- TIME STANDARDS: Swimmers must meet 12 & Under State Championship qualifying times as set by Wisconsin Swimming, available at www.wisconsinswimming.org.
- PROOF OF TIME: Swimmers who fail to achieve the time standard at the meet must prove they have achieved the time standard with a printed meet result or pay a \$50.00 fine before swimming their next event or the swimmer's team competes in any further relays. All swimmers disqualifying in individual events must also prove their times. The PROOF-OF-TIME table will be located outside of the pool office. Swimmers whose times are listed in the USA Swimming National Times data base will not have to come to the proof of times table. If a time is not available in the database, a proof of time must be presented. Time trials from this meet will not be accepted as a proof of time.
- SCRATCH RULES: Wisconsin Swimming scratch rule applies to this meet.
- POSITIVE CHECK-IN: Positive check-in will be required for all events that are 400 yards or longer, and all relays.
- DECK SEEDING: Deck entries will not be accepted. Relay only swimmers can deck enter up until the end of AM warm-up session for each day. Deck Registrations will not be accepted.
- ADAPTIVE SWIMMERS: Please indicate on the entries form any special needs for those athletes requiring assistance. Also, please inform the head official of those needs prior to the start of the meet.

Breaks for awards presentations will be determined once a meet timeline has been generated. The meet timeline will be posted online as soon as it is determined.
- COACHES: Meet packets can be picked up outside of the pool office. There will be a brief coaches meeting before the start of each day's meet. Meeting location will be announced during warm-ups.
- SCORING: This meet will be scored through 16th place, with double points for relays.
- OFFICIALS: Starter/Referee will be appointed by Wisconsin LSC.
Officials coordinator: Paul Young
- MEET CONDUCT: Each club is responsible for the conduct of its swimmers. Any person who, in the opinion of the Meet Director or Meet Marshall, is harmful to others or to other's property will be required to leave the competition.
- ADMISSIONS: There will be a charge for admission and heat sheets.

- PARKING:** Parking is located off of Tenny Avenue, and additional parking is available off of Roberta Avenue on North side of the school.
- FINAL RESULTS:** Each participating club shall receive one copy of final meet results. Additional copies of final results can be ordered for \$15.00.
- CONCESSIONS:** Delicious hot and cold foods will be available for purchase throughout the meet. Food is not allowed in the natatorium. Tables will be available in the cafeteria.

Time Trials
Sanction #2007-040WI

Time trials are only available to those swimmers entered in the 12 & Under State Championship meet.

- Times: Time trials will be offered as time permits, at the discretion of the meet director.
- Events: See meet order of events
- Registration: Swimmer must register at the meet management table located outside of the pool office. Entry deadlines will be posted once the timeline for the meet has been generated.
- Procedures: Swimmer must provide two timers, two watches, and counter (if needed)
- Meet host
Provides: Officials, Timing System Operator, and Meet Management
- Reminders: It is the responsibility of the swimmer to be at the blocks and ready to swim at the start of time trials. Card must be turned in after completion of time trial regardless if swim achieves desired cut time. A meeting will be held for all time trial participants and their timers at the start of each time trial session. Heat and lane assignments will be handed out at that time.
- Entry limits must be followed, time trials are included. The maximum number of individual swim allowed per day is four.
