Registration Fee: \$25; Fee includes Wisconsin Swimming Officials Manual and USA Swimming Mini Rule Book. A Club usually pays for or reimburses a participant for this fee.

Prior to the Clinic: Participants receive acknowledgement of pre-registrations and brief pre-clinic reading materials, including officiating philosophy. Materials sent by e-mail about a week prior to the Clinic.

At the Clinic: Participants view a "Stroke and Turn Judge" demonstration video produced by USA Swimming and discuss strokes, turns, finishes, relay exchanges, and deck assignments. Trainers discuss the Apprenticeships and the on-line USA Swimming test.

After Clinic: Participants join USA Swimming as non-athlete members, take the USA Swimming open book test, & apprentice for four Meet sessions on deck.
