- Eligibility:** Open to swimmers in the July 13, 2008, State & Non-State Meet
- Class of Meet:** Senior Event Time Trials
- Facility:** Indoor, 25 yard pool with 8 lanes (9 or 10 lanes if needed). Pool depth is 13 feet at the start and 5'10" at the bulkhead (turn end) with 30" starting blocks.
- Schedule:** At the conclusion of the PM Session
- Timing System:** A fully automatic Colorado timing system with 2 manual back-up buttons and two back-up timers for each lane will be used. If the automatic system fails, a gun or horn start will be used.
- General Rules:** Official 2008 USA Swimming and WI LSC rules shall prevail at this meet. Age as of July 13, 2008.
- Registration Deadline:** Register at the meet management table located in the computer room. Registration will be accepted during the AM and PM sessions up to a half hour before the end of the PM session. Swimmers in the last event of the day have 10 minutes after the end of that event to sign up for time trials.
- Entry Fees:** \$6.00 per individual event
- Entry Limit:** Participation is limited to a maximum of five (5) individual events per day which may be a combination of State/Non-State Meet individual events and Time Trials events.
- Disabled Swimmers:** Coaches are encouraged to inform Officials and the Meet Director of any disabled swimmer's needs prior to warm-ups.
- Format:** All events will be pre-seeded. Events will be combined when appropriate at the discretion of the meet management.
- Procedures:**
- Swimmer/s will sign up for an event at the meet management table.
 - Swimmer/s will fill out a seed card at the table—swimmer's name, age, team, event name, and seed time.
 - Seed card and event fee must be turned into the table before the registration deadline.

- An announcement will be made indicating the time that Time Trials will begin.
- A meeting for all time trial participants and timers will be held prior to the start of Time Trials.
- Cards with heat and lane assignments will be handed out at this meeting.
- It is the swimmer's responsibility to be ready to swim when his/her event, name and lane number are called. The Referee will not hold the start of the event waiting for a swimmer (or timer) to show.
- All Time Trial cards (whether or not a swimmer swims a desired time) MUST be turned in at the end of each heat to meet management.

Meet Host Provides: Officials, Colorado System Operator, Meet Management

Swimmers Provide: Two (2) timers, Two (2) watches, and counter (if needed)

Reminders:

1. Time Trials begin promptly. It is the responsibility of the swimmer to be at the blocks, complete with his/her timers, watches, ready to swim.
2. Turn in the Time Trial cards whether or not a swimmer achieves a desired time.

Admissions: None

Food: Food and beverages will be available during the meet. Coaches will show their USA Swimming Coaches card to receive complimentary food and drink.

Conduct: All coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and will see that their club has proper supervision at all times. Meet Marshals have the authority to remove any swimmer and/or spectator from the meet for any violation such as improper behavior, damage to property, etc. No smoking on the premises. Please encourage your parents and swimmers to clean up after themselves. Electronic devices and cameras are not allowed in the locker rooms.

First Aid: Report injuries to the Lifeguard and Meet Director. First aid kit is located at the Lifeguard stand.

Lost & Found: An area for lost and found will be designated at the meet. After the meet, please contact Jennifer Pennings at 262-752-0387 prior to July 28, 2008.

Meet Results: Results will be emailed to every club entered in the meet. Results will also be posted on the WI Swimming website. Clubs who prefer a paper copy of results must notify the meet management. Clubs who submit their entries on a disk may pick up their disk with results at the conclusion of the meet.
