

Proposal:

Divide the Wisconsin 12 & Under and 13 & Over State Championship meets into two divisions: Division I & Division II. The divisions will be determined by team size from the previous year and will last for a one-year period. Team size will be determined from the previous year's registration numbers for the current year. Registration numbers will come from the Wisconsin LSC registration chairperson, spanning a time from September 1<sup>st</sup> to August 31<sup>st</sup>. The top 15 teams in size from the previous year will compete in Division I. All other teams in the state will compete in Division II. (If two teams have the same total of registered athletes and rank 15 in total team size, both teams will compete in Division I) Teams will compete in the same division in both the Spring SC meet and the Summer LC meet for one year. Scoring and awards will be as follows:

- All events, individuals and relays, will be scored without regard to division
- Awards for individual and relay events will be awarded without regard to division
- Individual high point awards will be awarded without regard to division
- Age Group Team awards will be awarded without regard to division
- Female/Male Team awards will be awarded without regard to division
- Total Team High Point awards will be awarded to the top 5 teams in both Division I and Division II
- Scores will be totaled and then Division I teams and Division II teams separated with no change to point totals. Teams will achieve team awards within their respective division based on the amount of points scored with all teams scored together.
