

USA SWIMMING DISABILITY INTERNET CHALLENGE 2006-2007

Purpose: 1) To acknowledge swimmers with a disability at a grassroots level by providing an opportunity to share their competitive accomplishments; 2) To encourage swimmers with a disability to train with and compete for/with local USA Swimming member teams. 3) The emphasis of this event is participation and no attempt will be to rank by disability classification system.

Sponsor: USA Swimming Disability Committee.

Dates: September 1, 2006 through April 30, 2007

Eligibility: Open to all 2006 and/or 2007 USA Swimming registered athletes with a disability. Disability is defined as a permanent physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more major life activities.

Events: Swimmer may enter up to 3 events. Times should be listed in the age group of swimmer as of April 30, 2006. Age groups are 10&U, 11, 12, 13, 14,15, 16, 17 &18 (combined), 19 & over.

Entry **Entry forms must be received by May 31, 2007.** Complete attached entry form, being sure that times are recorded in USA-S SWIMS database and mail to Disability Internet Challenge, USA Swimming, One Olympic Plaza, Colorado Springs, CO 80909 or email to rjulian@USAswimming.org.

Postal Rules: Times must be from events swum in a short course pool in a sanctioned, approved or observed USA-S competition conducted anytime between September 1, 2006 and April 30, 2007. Submit best times in short course yards (Y) or short course meters (SCM). Short course meter times will be converted by the program and sorted with the yard times. Entry Forms must be received by May 31, 2007. **Times that cannot be verified in the SWIMS database will not be allowed.**
