- FACILITY:** Two 25 yard courses with Kiefer-McNeil lane lines will be utilized. Daktronics timing systems with scoreboard display will be used. The diving well will be available for supervised warm-up and cool-down throughout the meet.
- RULES:** Current USA Swimming and Indiana Swimming rules will govern this meet. Please pay special attention to USA Swimming Rules; 202.3.2: *At a sanctioned competitive event, USA Swimming athlete members must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down. The Meet Director or Meet Referee shall assist the athlete in making arrangements for such supervision.*
- As of October 1, 2009, USA Swimming has adopted the following amendment to rule 102.9. The Amendment to Rule 102.9B reads:
In swimming competitions, the competitor must wear only one swimsuit in one or two pieces except as provided in 205.10.1. All swimsuits shall be made from textile materials. For men, the swimsuit shall not extend above the navel nor below the knees, and for women, shall not cover the neck, extend past the shoulder, nor extend below the knee.
- ELIGIBILITY:** Swimmer(s) must be registered with USA Swimming and be between the ages of 11 and 14 to be accepted in this meet. Age as of November 20, 2009, shall determine swimmer's age for the entire meet. Coaches **MUST** constantly display their current USA Swimming coach credentials to gain deck access. The meet referee reserves the right to ask for coach credential display and/or deny deck access if coach does not comply or card is no longer valid/current.

FORMAT:

This will be an IMX meet. All athletes must participate in all events. The age group winners will be determined based upon their total IMX points.

Events will be swum in the normal 2-year age brackets, although scoring will be done for each age.

Athletes disqualified or scratched from any event will not be eligible for Total IMX points. All times in all events will be official.

SCORING:

Hy-Tek IMX Scoring will be used exclusively. Each time will be given a point value; swimmers scores from all events will be combined for an overall IMX point total. Disqualifications and scratches will receive zero points. Scoring and awards will be determined according to single-year age groupings and the swimmers' IMX totals. There will not be awards for individual events and there will be no team scoring.
