

As Team Wisconsin swam to victory at the Central Zone Meet many 13-14 swimmers contributed to the victory. Maddie Tew and Dot Halmy were the 13-14 girl individual event winners. Tew won the 200 Free and Halmy won the 400 Free. Tew also finished second in the 100 Free and fifth in the 400 Free. Halmy also finished second in the 200 Fly and fourth in the 200 Free. The following are the other Team Wisconsin 13-14 girls who made the podium by finishing in the top eight in their events. Shelby Rozeboom finished seventh in the 50 Free. Sarah Laabs finished third in the 1500 Free and fourth in the 800 Free. Kylie Engstrom finished sixth in the 1500 Free. Rina Krupsky finished third in the 400 IM, sixth in the 100 Back, and seventh in the 200 Back. Alicia Beam finished third in the 200 Back and seventh in the 100 Back. Nicole Bellford finished eighth in the 100 Fly. Steffi Durley finished fifth in the 200 Fly. The Team Wisconsin 200 and 400 Free Relays made the podium by finishing in the top three. The 200 relay consisted of Tew, Kendall Smith, Rozeboom, and Kelly Jacob while the 400 consisted of Tew, Smith, Halmy, and Jacob.

For the 13-14 boys Jared Klika finished second in the high point division. Klika won the 200 Back, finished second in the 50, 100, and 200 Free, and third in the 100 Fly and 200 IM. Ryan Scripp and Nicholas Potter also won events for Team Wisconsin. Scripp won the 200 IM and also finished third in the 200 Back, fourth in the 200 Free, fifth in the 50 and 100 Free, and sixth in the 100 Fly. Potter won the 400 IM and also finished second in the 1500 Free, fifth in the 200 IM, and seventh in the 200 Fly. The following are the other Team Wisconsin 13-14 boys who made the podium by finishing in the top eight in their events. Logan Kozlik finished fourth in the 50 Free. Ricky Perez finished second in the 100 Back, third in the 100 Free, and fifth in the 200 Free. Preston Vesely finished third in the 100 Back and fifth in the 200 Back. JP Paquette finished fourth in the 400 IM and eighth in the 200 Back. Thomas Stigler finished third in the 200 Breast and fifth in the 100 Breast. Ben Gebhart finished fourth in the 100 Fly. All four 13-14 Male Team Wisconsin relays made the podium by finishing in the top three. The 400 Free Relay consisting of Klika, Perez, Potter, and James Steinhoff and the 200 Medley of Vesely, Stigler, Gebhart, and Klika won. The 400 Medley Relay consisting of Perez, Stigler, Scripp, and Klika and the 200 Free Relay consisting of Kozlik, Perez, Steinhoff, and Aidan Meara finished third.
