Age Group Coach of the Year:

BRENT BOOCK—EBSC

Brent's swimmers helped EBSC jump from 9th to 5th in the team standings at the Division One 12+U Meet. All four age groups were in the top 6 at 12+U.

The 400 Free and 200 IM records had been set in 1982. Michael was also ranked 1st in the nation for 12 year old boys in the 200, 400, 800, and 1500 Free, with the 800 Free being ranked 3rd and the 1500 being ranked 4th all-time for 11-12 boys.

JACKSON MADONIA—DFAC 11-12 State Champion in 100 Free and 100 Butterfly. One of the most improved swimmers in the state.

Age Group FEMALE Swimmer of the year

Jon has 2012 long course top ten USA Swimming national rankings in six events for 15 year old boys. He won the second place 15-16 high point award at the state meet as a 15 year old with five firsts and one second place finish.

Only boy from Wisconsin with trial standards under the age of 19 this year Only boy from Wisconsin who attained Olympic Trial cut while still in high school.

Senior FEMALE Swimmer of the year

ABBY JAGFELD—WEST

Abby had a strong summer season and is emerging as a great swimmer. Abby's performances are a product of her willingness to work and her competitiveness. She dropped from a 2:05 in the 200 meter freestyle to a 2:02.59 qualifying her for the Olympic Trials, breaking the 15-16 state record and ranking 8th nationally in the 15-16 division. She was also selected to compete in the NCSA Dual Meet with japan this fall in Huntington Beach CA. She also showed big improvements in the 50 free (26.83), 100 free (57.32), and 400 free (4:21.58).

<u>SIERRA KUHN – VAC</u>

Sierra placed 9th in the 200 back at the 2012 Olympic Trials. Her time from the 200 back prelims (2:12.33) at the Trials ranks her 18th all-time in the 17-18 girls' Top 100 rankings. She is also ranked in the top 100 all-time for 17-18 girls in 3 other events, two of which were also attained this summer at trials (100 back and 200 IM). Sierra won the high point at the 2012 long course state meet for 17-18 girls.

<u>EMILY McCLELLAN-J-HAWK</u> Emily won the 100 Breast at the 2012 US Open. The win also secured a spot for Emily on the 2013 World University Games Team

Emily finished 8th in the 100 breast at the Olympic Trials.
